Invited Speaker Biographies



Professor Elisa Brietzke
Professor of Psychiatry, Queen's
University, Canada

Professor Elisa Brietzke is Full Professor of Psychiatry at Queen's University, Kingston, Ontario, Canada. She is an internationally recognized academic psychiatrist with expertise in mood disorders, biological psychiatry, and metabolic psychiatry. At Queen's University, she provides clinical care at Kingston Health Sciences Centre and leads translational research initiatives focused on the biological mechanisms of mood disorders, including inflammation, neuroplasticity, brain energetics, and nutritional and metabolic approaches to treatment.

Professor Brietzke has authored over 300 peer-reviewed publications, with an h-index above 80 and more than 24,000 citations. She is widely recognized for advancing innovative treatment strategies in psychiatry and for bridging neuroscience, metabolism, and clinical practice



Professor Claudio Soares
MD, PhD, FRCPC, MBA
Professor at Queens University,
Canada

Prof. Soares is a Full Professor and former Chair in the Department of Psychiatry at Queen's University School of Medicine in Kingston, Ontario. He currently serves as the inaugural Director of the Centre for Psychedelics Health and Research at Providence Care Hospital & Queen's University, Executive Lead for the Canadian Biomarker Integration Network in Depression (CAN-BIND), and Regional Lead for Mental Health and Addictions at Ontario Health East.

He was recently appointed Executive Director of the Canadian Menopause Society, after serving as a Board Member and President of the Menopause Society.

Prof. Soares trained as a psychiatrist, completed his Ph.D. on the effects of estrogen for the management of depression in midlife women, and pursued a postdoctoral fellowship in perinatal and reproductive psychiatry at Massachusetts General Hospital, Harvard Medical School. His research has focused primarily on novel hormonal and non-hormonal options for midlife women experiencing mood and anxiety disorders, vasomotor symptoms, and sleep problems. He is also interested in the use of wearables and digital health technologies to monitor depression and sleep disturbances, as well as the use of psychedelics for psychiatric disorders and existential distress in late-stage cancer.

Prof. Soares is a sought-after educator, with more than 240 presentations at national and international meetings and over 200 peer reviewed publications in mood disorders and women's mental health, including in JAMA, Nature, and the American Journal of Psychiatry.



**Professor Gustavo H. Vázquez,
MD, PhD, FRCPC Professor of
Psychiatry, Queen's University,
Canada**

Prof. Gustavo H. Vázquez is a psychiatrist and clinician-scientist specializing in treatment-resistant mood disorders and interventional psychiatry. His research focuses on the integration of clinical phenotyping, treatment resistance frameworks, neurobiological mechanisms, and the implementation of advanced somatic therapies, including intravenous ketamine, intranasal esketamine, electroconvulsive therapy (ECT), and repetitive transcranial magnetic stimulation (rTMS).

Over the past decade, he has led and co-led large-scale data base-driven studies in tertiary mood disorder populations, examining treatment-resistant depression, bipolar disorder, medication burden, and staging models of illness progression. He has served as Principal Investigator on multiple competitive research grants investigating the efficacy, durability, safety, and cognitive outcomes of ketamine-based treatments, and as Co-Investigator on CIHR-funded biomarker studies within the Canadian Biomarker Integration Network in Depression (CAN-BIND).

His research integrates clinical methodology with translational neuroscience, incorporating symptom trajectories, cognitive markers, and neuroimaging approaches such as resting-state fMRI and diffusion tensor imaging (DTI) to better understand predictors of treatment response. Prof. Vázquez is Professor of Psychiatry at Queen's University and currently serves as Chair of the Department of Psychiatry Reappointments and Promotions Committee, contributing to academic mentorship, research development, and knowledge translation in psychiatric practice.

Prof. Tarek Qassem is a UK-trained consultant psychiatrist specializing in older adult psychiatry. During his work in the United Kingdom, he served as a Consultant in Old Age Psychiatry, where he led a neurocognitive clinic responsible for the assessment and management of patients presenting with cognitive symptoms and neurocognitive disorders.

He previously served as Chair of the Research and Innovation Committee in a National Health Service (NHS) Trust in the West Midlands, serving a population of approximately 1.1 million people, and held academic appointments as an Honorary Fellow and Senior Lecturer at the University of Warwick.

Prof. Qassem currently serves as Clinical Academic Group Lead for Mental Health of Older Adults at Maudsley Health, Al Amal Psychiatric Hospital in Dubai, and holds an appointment as an Adjunct Clinical Professor at Mohammed Bin Rashid University of Medicine and Dubai Medical College. He has also served as Chair of the Research and Innovation Committee at Al Amal Hospital and Academic Lead for Maudsley Health services.

He has authored multiple peer-reviewed publications in high-impact journals, including The British Journal of Psychiatry and The BMJ, and has contributed book chapters in several areas of psychiatry.

Dr. Zerak Al-Salihi is a Senior Consultant Old Age Psychiatrist at Hamad Medical Corporation (HMC), Qatar. He completed his specialist training in the United Kingdom and was awarded a Certificate of Completion of Training (CCT) in Old Age Psychiatry in August 2014. He subsequently joined Hamad Medical Corporation in September 2015, where he currently works at Al-Wakra Hospital as part of a newly established Liaison Psychiatry team.

Dr. Al-Salihi also serves as Fellowship Program Director in Old Age Psychiatry and leads a multidisciplinary clinical team consisting of a clinical fellow, specialist psychiatrist, and senior psychiatric nurses. In addition to his clinical and educational roles, he holds an academic appointment as Assistant Professor of Clinical Psychiatry at Weill Cornell Medicine–Qatar.

He represents the Psychiatry Department at the Ministry of Public Health in the Global Dementia Observatory (GDO) and has contributed to the development of dementia clinical guidelines for Hamad Medical Corporation, which are published on the corporation's official platform.

Dr. Deemah Alateeq is a consultant psychiatrist with a subspecialty in women's mental health. She graduated from the College of Medicine at King Saud University, then completed her residency in psychiatry and obtained the Saudi Board in Psychiatry. She later pursued her subspecialty training in Canada and earned a Fellowship in Women's Mental Health from McGill University. She also holds a Master's degree in Entrepreneurship and Innovation from the University of London.

Dr. Alateeq has published more than 40 scientific articles on psychiatry and women's mental health in peer-reviewed journals and has presented her work at international conferences. She contributes actively to academic publications and currently serves as an Associate Professor of Psychiatry at a College of Medicine.

In addition to her academic and clinical roles, Dr. Alateeq is the Head of the Standing Committee for Scientific Research and Publication at the Saudi Psychiatric Association and a member of the Women's Committee at the Family Affairs Council in Saudi Arabia.

Dr. Maha Al Ali is an Emirati Consultant Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist based at Al Jalila Children's Specialty Hospital in Dubai. She specializes in the assessment and management of a wide range of child and adolescent mental health conditions, including neurodevelopmental disorders, anxiety disorders, mood disorders, and behavioral challenges.

Dr. Al Ali has played a leading role in advancing child mental health services in the United Arab Emirates. She was part of a team recognized with the Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Foundation Award for contributing to the development and implementation of an innovative Autism Assessment Pathway within Primary Health Care, which significantly improved access to timely autism assessments for children and families.

In addition to her clinical work, Dr. Al Ali is actively involved in medical education, professional training, and public mental health advocacy. She regularly delivers lectures, workshops, and conference presentations for healthcare professionals, educators, and families on topics related to child development, parenting, neurodevelopmental disorders, and emotional wellbeing.

Dr. Al Ali serves on the Board of the Emirates Society for Child and Adolescent Mental Health (ESCAM) and contributes to several national initiatives aimed at improving awareness, early identification, and evidence-based care for children and young people. She is also a frequent contributor to television, radio, and digital media platforms, where she promotes child and adolescent mental health and works to make mental health information accessible to the wider community.

Zainab Imam is an experienced adult and perinatal psychiatrist with over 35 years in medicine and currently serves as the Division Chief of Women's Mental Health at Sidra Medicine. She specializes in the assessment and treatment of perinatal mental health conditions, including prenatal and postnatal mood disorders, psychosis, preconception planning, and complex medication management. Her expertise also extends to general adult mental health conditions such as anxiety, depression, ADHD, OCD, PTSD, bipolar disorder, and psychosis.

Before joining Sidra Medicine, Dr. Imam held academic and teaching roles in the UK, including serving as a clinical teacher and examiner at University of Plymouth, where she contributed to the training of medical students and psychiatric trainees. She also held leadership roles in psychiatric education and tele-psychiatry services.

Beyond clinical practice, Dr. Imam is deeply involved in mental health advocacy and humanitarian work, serving as a trustee, co-founder, and patron of several organizations focused on healthcare access, refugee support, and mental health awareness in Nigeria and the UK. Since joining Sidra Medicine in 2018, she has contributed significantly to medical education and global maternal mental health initiatives, including leading annual World Maternal Mental Health Day celebrations and supporting international collaboration in women's mental health.



Dr. Najat Alzbeidi, M.B.B.S., is a Consultant Psychiatrist at Sakina, Abu Dhabi Healthcare Company (SEHA), in Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates.

Dr. Alzbeidi is a highly skilled psychiatrist with extensive expertise in interventional psychiatry, specialising in mood disorders, women's mental health, and neuromodulation services. She completed her medical training at the Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland and October 6 University in Egypt, followed by a psychiatry residency at Sheikh Khalifa Medical City in the UAE. Dr. Alzbeidi holds a fellowship in mood disorders from Queen's University in Canada, a mini fellowship in behavioural sleep medicine from the University of Pennsylvania, USA, and specialised certification in repetitive transcranial magnetic stimulation (rTMS) from the Temerty Centre for Therapeutic Brain Intervention at the University of Toronto, Canada.

Her clinical focus is on treating resistant cases of depression, anxiety, and bipolar disorders, using evidence-based therapies for improved patient outcomes. A passionate advocate for women's mental health, Dr. Alzbeidi provides specialised care for women during pregnancy and postpartum, helping to support mental well-being throughout the motherhood journey. She is dedicated to advancing mental health awareness in the UAE, conducting workshops and community initiatives to combat the stigma around psychiatric conditions. A published researcher and speaker.
